- All manuscripts should be submitted electronically via the ScholarOne Manuscripts website located at: <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/LNCN>.
- Select under manuscript type: Special Issue: PP11 symposium.
- Please indicate this preference as well in the details and comments part.
- In preparation and submission you should follow the general journal guidelines.

In addition to the guidelines provided by the journal please take care of some general guidelines for manuscript preparation based on errors observed earlier for previous editions. These also help the editors to determine easily whether the papers fall within the journal guidelines and special issue criteria.

General page settings:

- Start 2.54 cm (1 inch from the top)
- Lower margin: 2.54 cm; left and right margin: 2.54 cm
- Use double or 1.5 spacing for the whole manuscript

Title page:

- **Title bold and larger font** (limit 25 words)
- two open lines (single spaced) between title and authors
- **use correct sequence for authors: initials followed by name, no full name (all bold)**
- one open line (single spaced) between authors and affiliations
- affiliations
- text should be justified for all following sections
- use Times New Roman font (12)

Abstract

- Include a short abstract according to journal guidelines (limit 250 words)
- **ABSTRACT in capitals; Bold**
- Include one open line between abstract and key words
- 4-5 key words

Headings:

- **INTRODUCTION (bold heading in CAPITALS)**
- **MATERIALS AND METHODS in BOLD CAPITALS**
- **RESULTS (BOLD HEADING)**
- **DISCUSSION (BOLD HEADING)**
- **REFERENCES (bold heading)**
- For a review different headings may be used

- **For clarity the use of subheadings is recommended.**
- Tables and/or Figures should be placed at the end.

- REFERENCES should be numerical as they appear in the text; use provided format. DO not give month or issue of publication. Give all authors. E.g.:

Hewitt, C. 1978. Burnout, in *Two-Phase Flows and Heat Transfer with Application to Nuclear Reactor Design Problems*, ed. J. J. Cinoux, Hemisphere, Washington, DC, 1978, pp. 133-155. (chapter in a book)

Ghajar, A.J.; Tam, L.M. Flow regime map for a horizontal pipe with uniform wall heat flux and three inlet configuration, *Exp. Therm. Fluid Sci.* **1995**, 10, 287-297. (article)

Length (in print in the journal):

- 4-6 journal print pages for poster presentations
 - Word file: about 1500-2000 words, excluding abstract, but with references and text Tables; up to 2 figures/Tables
- 6-8 journal print pages oral presentations
 - Word file: about 2000-3500 words, excluding abstract, but with references and text Tables; up to 3-4 figures/Tables
- 10-12 journal print pages for invited speakers
 - Word file: about 3000-5500 words, excluding abstract, but with references and text Tables; up to 4-5 figures/Tables
